Handwritten Journal - Copies of Royal Patent Deeds

This handwritten journal (author unknown) was "Found in Collections", and appears to be handwritten copies of the following materials.

1. Translation No. 535. Kamehameha III by his Royal Patent grants to James W. Smith for \$567.50 in 1851. Land at Moloaa, K aamaanui and Papaa and containing 567 and 7/16 acres more or less. Rights of native tenants and ten acres of N. Kahele are reserved.
2. By-Laws regulating the "Shareholders" of the lands of Aliomanu, Papaa, Moloaa and Kaapuna and called the "Hui Land". The By-Laws contain 14 Articles certified in October 1868 by Moses Kaanaana (Luna Nui) and W.P. Pakekee, A.S. Nuuanu, and D. Kaulei, the committee of Executives. (This appears to be a draft of #3 which follows).
3. By-Laws regulating shareholders of lands of Aliomanu, Papaa, Moloaa, Kaapuna. Contains 15 Articles. Unsigned and undated.
4. Note dated February "Copy of Royal Patent Deeds", W.A. Widermann to John Hoff et al.
