Abstract:

Correspondence between a World War II soldier and his sister beginning when Private Katsuki Tanigawa was at Camp Shelley, Mississippi in 1943 and ending in 1946, as a Master Sergeant with an address at the Tokyo Army Hospital Annex. All three letters are addressed to Mrs. Lillian Sugibayashi the former Lillian S. Tanigawa.

Additional items in the collection includes a 1923 Kapaa School class photograph with Lillian's photo; an undated newspaper clipping about the Miyashiro brothers who were soldiers in Korea; and 2 newspaper photograph of the polo field at Waipouli and the Kealia Mill.

The list of all students who appeared in the 1923 Kapaa School class is on the finding aid on the next page.
