G.N. Wilcox Hospital in the Twentieth Century by Pat L. Griffin, 2000 Supporting Documents

Abstract:

The <u>Wilcox Memorial Hospital</u>, written by Pat L. Griffin and published by the Wilcox Hospital Foundation was released in 2000. Griffin submitted the information to the American Association for State and Local History in 2001. The extensive presentation information follows the early days of the hospital for the Lihue Plantation Company's employees and families, through the years of change and expansion and up to 2000. Supporting documents collected by the author supplement the presentation materials.

Biography:

Pat was raised in Florida and after high school she entered the World Campus Afloat program at Chapman College and then attended St. Mary's Dominican College receiving her B.A. in history, and did graduate work at Goddard College for an M.S. in history. A Certificate Program at the Smithsonian Institution/George Washington University of Appraisal of Fine and Decorative Arts was completed in 1996.

She is the present owner of Griffin Noyes Associates, originally named Pat Griffin Graphic Design in 1977, and general editor of Aloha from Hawaii (internet magazine) since 1995.

Griffin's interactions with cultural and educational clients highlight her involvement in the Kauai community of non-profit activities and include historical entities such as Grove Farm and Waioli Mission House Museums, the Kauai Public Land Trust, National Tropical Botanical Garden, Island School, and the Kauai Historical Society. Her interactions with these and other community groups lead to an active participation on the boards of the Zonta Club, Garden Island Arts Council, Mayor's Council on Culture and the Arts, YMCA, Kauai Chamber of Commerce, as well as serving on the State Historical Review Commission, and other commitments to Kauai's service organizations. She continues to volunteer her time and expertise to many Kauai projects.
