Student Letters to Miss Mabel Vogel

Mabel Vogel was a teacher at Waimea in 1919, teaching the 3rd grade class. This archive includes letters from her students after she returned to the mainland, from August through December 1919, with 2 additional letters dated 1920-1921.

Mabel Vogel's photograph album, dated 1918-1919, provides copies of photographs of students during this school year. Six photographs are identified but it does not include photographs of 8 of the Waimea students.

Mabel Vogel graduated from Teacher's College, Columbia University in 1919. In 1926, she was the co-author with Charleton W. Washburne of, *What Children Like to Read*, funded by the American Library Association and published in Chicago by Rand McNally Co. in 1928. They also co-authored the following two journal articles: *Two years of Winnetka Research*, *Public School* in the Journal of Educational Research, February 2028, v. 17 pages 90-101; and *Revised list of phonics for grade* 2 in the Elementary School Journal, v. 28, June 2028.

The Hawaiian Historical Society sent these original Waimea student letters to the Kauai Historical Society in 2012 at the request of the then Director Mary Requilman. A photo copy of each letter is located in the Hawaii Historical Society as well as additional items.

These records came to the Kauai Historical Society August 6, 2012, from the Hawaiian Historical Society, part of the donated items from Ms. Pattie Joseph in 2012. The records are open to research without restrictions.
