**Abstract:**

Various photographic exhibits created by Carol Yotsuda.

**History:**

Carol Yotsuda's collection of Kaua'i images over the period 2004-2017 covers a wide spectrum of Kaua'i life styles and island events, with outstanding photographs.

Contents of each set of photographs, in the groups as provided by the donor, with a brief summary of the images, their locations, with the dates – some provided from the processing of the films. All are in color, most were displayed in the Lihue Airport for information and decoration - as well as providing current entertainment opportunities for visitors. The written captions provide many dates and locations; however, they were not attached with the individual images; some provide additional information about other photographers whose work is included.

**Acquisition information:** These records came to the historical society on Aug. 19, 2019 deposited by Carol Yotsuda. **Restrictions:** These records are open to research but have some restrictions.
